FACTS NOT FANCIES

1,000,000 Illinois citizens live in territory where taverns are not permitted.
896 Illinois political units have voted DRY since repeal of the 18th amendment. They are divided as follows:

133 Precincts, and parts of precincts, in Chicago.

258 Cities, towns and villages.

507 Unincorporated townships and road-districts.

1,000,000 other Illinois citizens CAN ABOLISH taverns from their doorsteps in 1944 and 1945. Chicago Precincts may vote in November 1944, and next in November 1946. Towns and townships in every part of the State may vote in April 1945.

A unit may vote on Local Option ONLY when officers for the voting unit are being elected.

Local Option Election leadership and advice wherever possible, whenever legal.
