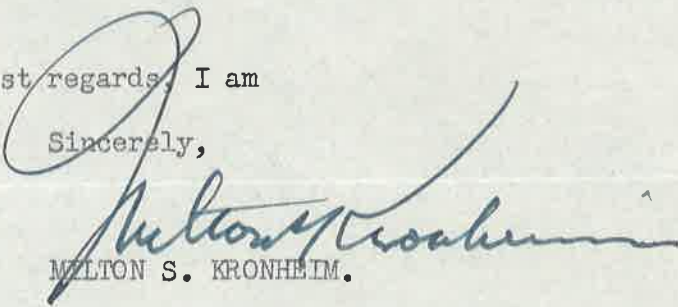
Dear Senator:

There is a Bill (H. R. 4971) being considered by the Senate, which provides for the elimination of price in the advertising of liquor. It has the endorsement of many civic groups in this city, as well as the support of almost the entire industry. It has been UNANIMOUSLY approved by a Sub-Committee of the House District Committee, by the Full House District Committee, and by the House itself.

I am taking the liberty of addressing you, Sir, because it has just come to my attention that your home State has such a regulation, and feeling that you might be motivated by the action of the people of your State to interest yourself in our local problem, I am asking you to -- if you will -- take our point of view, as well as that of your own State, and urge the passage of this Bill.
