I have just read your speech of March 12th with great interest. I think it was an excellent speech and most timely but please enlighten me.

I understand from your remarks that S 860 has to do with conditions within a military camp or base. Is there not some legislation pending either in the House or the Senate which would cover the recreational area around a camp or base as well as within the same? If not, will you please give me the number of the companion bill in the House so that I may write to our Congressman?

I was in the United States Navy in World War No. 1 and I well recall the order of Secretary Daniels regarding the use of alcoholic beverages in the armed forces of the Navy. I think the order added much to the efficiency and morale of the men. When there is tough work to do, like going into battle, one needs every favorable element - most of all a clear head. The incidents which you relate in your speech are all too true.
